

6 WAYS TO SUPPORT CLEAR CREEK



Collect Box Tops for Education from various General Mills products. Turn the Box Tops into your child's teacher or the office. Clear Creek can redeem this for the amount indicated on them. Last year we raised over \$700.



Collect Campbell labels and turn them in to your child's teacher or the office. Clear Creek can redeem this labels from Campbell's.



If you have a Safeway Card and have shopped at Safeway between July 18 and September 4 you may have earned money for a school of your choice. After September 4th you will receive a certificate from Safeway with amount and certificate number. Turn this certificate in to your child's teacher or the office. Clear Creek can redeem this for the amount indicated on them.



If you shop at Office Depot sign up for their 5% Back To Schools Program. All you have to do is:

- Buy qualifying student school supplies at Office Depot
- Designate Clear Creek to receive 5% of your qualifying purchase
- Office Depot will tally the qualifying purchases made during the program period
- Office Depot will award Clear Creek 5% of the qualifying purchases in credits the school can use for FREE SUPPLIES!*



If you shop at Target and have a Target Red Card you can designate Clear Creek to receive a total 1% of your purchases at Target and Target.com and 1/2% of Target Visa Credit Card purchases made everywhere Visa credit cards are accepted. Simply sign up to get a Target Red Card and then designate Clear Creek as the recipient school.



EScrip.com is a website that allows you register your Safeway Card or other cards and earn money for Clear Creek at no cost to you.

Here's How it Works

- You register any one or all of your existing grocery loyalty, debit and credit cards for use in the program.
- Participating merchants will make contributions to your chosen group, based on purchases made by you, just by using the cards you have registered.
- Your purchases are tracked and available to you online, allowing you to see just how much you are earning on your child's behalf!
